Reducing Emergency Department wait times

Despite facing a 5% increase in patient visits over the previous year alone, PRHC's Emergency Department continues to consistently rank in the top 10 of the 72 Ontario hospitals participating in a provincial program intended to decrease Emergency Department wait times.

24 new inpatient beds

Last fall PRHC made the decision to permanently open 24 new inpatient beds to help alleviate sustained increases in patient volumes. Those beds remain open today.

National patient safety award

Last year, PRHC was awarded a national Patient Safety Champion Award by the Canadian Patient Safety Institute (CPSI) for taking a leadership role in paving the way to safer healthcare and ensuring that patients and their families are at the centre of their safety initiatives.

Physician recruiting

PRHC remains the largest employer in the region with more than 2400 staff, 400 physicians and 600 volunteers. Nearly twice as many physicians were recruited last year over the year before, with 34 new physicians welcomed between July 2017 and June 2018. Recruitment of another 30 physicians is currently underway. On June 8, 2018, PRHC celebrated the 10th anniversary of the day the doors to the brand new 715,000-square-foot facility opened for the first time.



PRHC's supportive housing for seniors partnership with Peterborough Housing Corporation (PHC) and the Central East LHIN continues to move forward and is expected to be ready for residents in 2019. 20 units in the 80-unit development will be reserved for PRHC's Alternate Level of Care (ALC) patients, allowing them to live safely, comfortably and affordably within the community, maintaining independence while also receiving the necessary level of daily care.
