Reimagining healthcare: PRHC Foundation launches historic \$60 million Campaign for PRHC

On June 25, the Peterborough Regional Health Centre (PRHC) Foundation launched a \$60 million fundraising campaign — the largest ever in the hospital and PRHC Foundation's history.

This ambitious campaign is a response to the demands of the changing healthcare landscape and an opportunity to bring lifesaving new services to our region, fuel innovation, and attract the best and brightest healthcare professionals to PRHC. With a growing and rapidly aging population, increased patient volumes, and rising rates of chronic disease and mental illness, the need for complex care is increasing. Continued investment in PRHC, which is over 16 years old, is essential to address these challenges.

"We are at a crossroads," said Lesley Heighway, PRHC Foundation President & CEO. "Our hospital and the communities we serve are facing serious problems. We need creative, inspired, efficient solutions to tackle them. Without advancements in technology and increased capacity, we risk leaving our patients behind. Today, with our donors, we choose to design our healthcare future."

PRHC is your regional hospital

More than 600,000 people rely on PRHC for care close to home, including patients from Peterborough and Peterborough County, Lindsay and all areas within the City of Kawartha Lakes, Campbellford, Havelock, Cobourg and Port Hope, Port Perry, east Oshawa and parts of the Durham region, north to the Haliburton Highlands, and all points in between

PRHC has a \$390 million annual operating budget and up to 500 inpatient beds currently in use - it's a place where world-class patient care is provided 24 hours a day, seven days a week

PRHC is a fully integrated hub for care, like Kingston General Hospital, Lakeridge Health, and Scarborough Health Network

PRHC supports four partner hospitals: Campbellford Memorial, Northumberland Hills, Ross Memorial, and Haliburton Highlands Health Services

Our partner hospitals refer patients to PRHC's **Regional Centres of Excellence** for cancer, cardiac and vascular care, as well as its **regional referral programs,** including mental health and addictions, surgical and laboratory services, the Neonatal ICU, and District Stroke Centre

My journey with PRHC has been a significant part of my life for many years. I began as a donor and in 2000 had the privilege of chairing PRHC's Breaking New Ground Campaign to build the new hospital.

That campaign was a tremendous success. We aimed to raise \$10 million, but thanks to our incredible community, we raised \$14.5 million. It has come full circle for me, and I still feel a deep sense of accomplishment and connection from that time, which I know many of you share. Cardiac Care - \$11 million

Unlock opportunities and put the people, infrastructure, systems and programs in place to allow world-class cardiac care across the spectrum, including a new Cardiac Electrophysioloy Lab



Cancer Care - \$12 million

Treat more patients with more cancer types, support earlier diagnosis, and ensure more effective treatments with advancements such as digital pathology and an expanded Pediatric Cancer Care Unit



Minimally Invasive Intervention - \$14 million

Thanks to you, we're already 75% of the way to our goal with \$45.5 million raised to date

The impact of your early support is being felt through exciting campaign investments already made, such as:

- The upgrade and replacement of two Cardiac Cath Lab suites with state-of-the-art technology for better visualization and shorter, safer procedures
- Two new cutting-edge CT scanners to support the early diagnosis of cancer and other conditions
- A second MRI to facilitate up to 5,000 more procedures a year, addressing wait times from a 53% increase in demand and improving diagnostic care close to home
- The renovation and upgrade of the interventional radiology suites to enhance patient care and introduce endovascular thrombectomy (EVT) here for the first time to stop strokes instantly

- The upgrade of four general operating rooms with advanced minimally invasive tools so experts can perform essential surgeries with new, fluorescenceguided imaging and increased precision
- The opening of the new Scotiabank Youth Eating Disorders Day Treatment Clinic to support youth aged 12-25 who need lifesaving care to normalize eating and restore weight
- Urgent needs as identified by the hospital, including critical equipment and technology that supported PRHC's new designation as a Level III Trauma Centre

Dr. Lynn Mikula, PRHC's President & CEO, believes that PRHC is at a crucial turning point and ready to accomplish great things, but that it won't be possible without the support of donors. Endorsing the campaign, she said:

"PRHC is a thriving organization, home to incredibly dedicated and compassionate professionals, but the present and future are not without their challenges. We simply can't move forward without the partnership of individuals, families, and organizations who share our vision for this hospital and what we can achieve together."

The campaign focuses on raising funds for extensive hospital investments in cardiac care, cancer care, minimally invasive surgeries, interventional radiology, mental health and addictions services, and a physician-driven innovation accelerator. Since 2020, the PRHC Foundation has been working with donors to build support for the campaign, and these efforts have already raised \$45.5 million.

The funds raised to date have supported early campaign projects such as upgraded Cardiac Cath Lab suites, stateof-the-art CT scanners, a second MRI machine, the new Scotiabank Youth Eating Disorders Day Treatment Clinic, and ongoing renovations to enhance patient care facilities. Future investments through the campaign will include cardiac care advancements such as a new lab that will allow experts to treat electrical conditions of the heart.

In support of cancer care, PRHC will be able to bring digital pathology to the Laboratory, implement breast seed localization for better surgical outcomes and faster patient recovery, and create an expanded Pediatric Cancer Care Unit to provide safe and expert treatment for children.

Campaign fundraising will also enable enhancement of minimally invasive interventions with an advanced hybrid operating room for multiple procedures on a single patient, and improved vascular care for safer and more comfortable outcomes.

For mental health and addictions services, donations will fund healing spaces, such as an expansion of the Emergency Department's Crisis Response Unit and a new, secure outdoor courtyard for the Psychiatric Intensive Care Unit.

Critical to it all is the support of every donor, said Heighway: "We have the generous community to get us to our goal. Every single donation, big and small, will contribute to the success of the \$60 million Campaign for PRHC."
